**1. APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

**2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES- REGULAR MEETING HELD JULY 21, 2016:**

**3. ILLEGAL DUMPING-** Dave Gillan brought forth the issue of the illegal dumping cameras that were supposed to have been installed in county areas. Steve McCroskey reported to the committee that the cameras have yet to be put up, so no report is able to be made. The county is planning to build a convenience site for county residents, but has yet to be started. McCroskey reports that having support from the Sheriff's office is very important in combatting illegal dumping in the county. He also states that illegal dumping ordinances are in the process of being reviewed and he hopes to see the changes in effect by spring of next year. Jerry Stanley stated that in Ruidoso cameras have been put up around town and illegal dumpers are made known publicly without posting names.

**4. KCB- Business of the Month-** Jim Grantner suggested the newly painted and fixed up muffler shop at the Y be considered and mentioned that it's nice to see older buildings being revised and updated. The committee agreed and Mary Garwood will visit with them to schedule the award presentation.

**5. ANTI DRUG/GANG COALITION-** Joana Wells advised the committee that the next prescription drug takeback event will be Saturday, October 22, 2016 at the Carlsbad Beach parking lot. Joana said that the new CVS pharmacy will offer a 24/7 drug takeback service.

**7. Code Enforcement-** Further discussion was made regarding illegal dumping and weeds. The dumpster to rollout conversion is nearly completed by the solid waste department and on September 1<sup>st</sup> the Solid Waste Department will no longer service the alleys. A couple of addresses were given to code enforcement for investigation.

**7. Recycling** – No report given.

**8. COMMUNITY CONCERNS DISCUSSION/UPDATE-** Mary Garwood states she will be working on community cleanups by coordinating a Hobbs Highway cleanup soon in correlation with Eddy County. A date will be given at next month's meeting. Jim Grantner suggested that Code Enforcement and/or Beautification begin writing a monthly article in the Carlsbad Current Argus newspaper to keep residents informed about codes and any information.
