

AUTOMATED REFUSE COLLECTION (ARC) TRUCK DRIVER

The City of Carlsbad is accepting applications for the position of ARC Truck Driver. This position operates ARC trucks for the Solid Waste Department.

Operates an automated refuse collection truck (container truck) to collect solid waste/refuse in an assigned area of the City.

Drives filled container truck to the landfill and discharges the contents in the location directed by the landfill staff.

Cleans and performs operator maintenance on assigned container truck.

Knowledge of the street names and locations in the City of Carlsbad. Knowledge of the operating procedures for automated refuse collection trucks.

Skill in understanding and following written and verbal instructions. Skill in operating and maintaining an automated refuse collection truck.

Ability to lift objects weighing 75 lbs. or more. Ability to perform tasks requiring manual dexterity.

Must have a high school diploma or GED. Experience equivalent to two (2) years full-time work driving a medium to large commercial truck. Must possess a valid Class B, or equivalent, State of New Mexico commercial driver's license (CDL). Must have an excellent work history to include dependability and stability.

In addition to an excellent benefit package, starting hourly base wage will be \$18.80. Additional increases will be given for a Class A CDL license, advanced education degrees and specialty certifications.

After completion of probationary period employees may receive base rate increase, up to \$23.50, depending on previous driving experience and upon demonstrating a knowledge of and proficiency in three (3) of the established collection routes.

Applicants must include a City of Carlsbad employment application filled out completely. Resumes are not required, but may be included if desired.
