

## HVAC TECHNICIAN

The City of Carlsbad is seeking an experienced HVAC Technician. Performs journey level work to install, repair, trouble shoot and maintain a variety of heating, ventilation and air conditioning equipment and systems.

Installs, maintains, overhauls, repairs and/or replaces a variety of HVAC equipment and system components, including compressors, motors, electronic controls, and fans to ensure their efficient operation.

Designs and coordinates the installation of HVAC systems used in City facilities.

Tests a variety of HVAC equipment to diagnose/identify repair/maintenance needs or to determine if the equipment needs to be replaced using accepted electronic testing/diagnosis equipment and procedures.

Estimates maintenance/repair costs and researches replacement costs to recommend to management the most cost effective option(s).

Knowledge of the principles/practices of installing, maintaining, and repairing a wide variety of HVAC equipment and systems.

Knowledge of the procedures for the installation, repair, and maintenance of a variety of HVAC equipment and systems.

Knowledge of the accepted equipment and procedures used in testing/diagnosing HVAC equipment and systems.

Knowledge of the various HVAC equipment and systems used within the City.

Ability to lift and move objects weighing more than 75 lbs.

Skill in diagnosing problems in a variety of HVAC equipment and systems. Skill in installing, repairing, and maintaining a variety of HVAC equipment, systems, and controls. Skill in designing and building HVAC systems. Skill in reading and understanding blueprints, plans, and schematic diagrams. Skill in understanding and following complex written and verbal instructions. Skill in establishing and maintaining effective working relationships with other City staff and the public.

Qualifications: Experience equivalent to three (3) years full time work diagnosing and repairing heating, ventilation, and air conditioning equipment/systems; AND completion of an HVAC technician program from an accredited technical/trade school; OR equivalent combination of experience and education.

Must be able to work overtime, call outs, weekends and holidays as needed.

A New Mexico State Journeyman Sheet Metal (JSM) license, a Journeyman Gas (JG) license and a New Mexico State Journeyman Electrical (JE98) license is desired but not required.

Must have an excellent work history to include dependability and stability. Must possess and maintain a valid New Mexico operator's license.

In addition to an excellent benefit package, starting base hourly rate will be \$29.59 with increase to \$32.88 at completion of probationary period.
