



NOTICE OF DETERMINATION  
for  
EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT

4/20/15

On April 20, 2016 a critical U-bolt at the primary sewer lift station was broken during maintenance and repair operations. The U-bolt is critical to the functioning of the lift station. If the repairs are not performed immediately the City runs the risk of raw sewage overflowing and dumping into the Pecos River creating an environmentally hazardous situation for humans and native wild life.

Due to the need to have this work performed immediately and the need for specialized equipment to lower a workman into the lift station in a cage to prevent the risk of serious injury or death, the services of M & M Equipment was solicited to perform the repair. M & M possesses the necessary equipment and capability to perform the repair and a readily available local source for the job.

The City of Carlsbad has determined it is necessary to declare any and all purchases needed to correct the problem an emergency procurement.

The services of M & M Excavating have been procured to perform the repairs in the amount of \$3,715.63. (PO# 168407)

In order to expedite the repairs and alleviate a potential public health and environmental issue, the City is making the determination to proceed with this purchase as an Emergency Procurement as defined in (Section 1.4.1.58-64) of the New Mexico State Procurement Code.
