New Utilities Director Announced

The City of Carlsbad's Superintendent of the Double Eagle Water System has been promoted to Director of Utilities, Carlsbad Mayor Dale Janway announced.

Ron Myers joined the City of Carlsbad as a Double Eagle supervisor in 2012 and has served as superintendent of the system since 2014.

"What really stands out about Ron is his commitment and dedication," said Carlsbad Mayor Dale Janway. "He is very well regarded for his work with the Double Eagle system, and we know he will do an excellent job."

Myers holds a "Water 4" certification from the New Mexico Environment Department. He also holds a Bachelor's degree in civil engineering with an emphasis in water resources.
