Addendum Notice – Dark Canyon Bridge Project

The City of Carlsbad has been asked the following question regarding RFP 2017-01 and offers the following response in blue text:

The description of the project scope of work is not clear as to whether there are two bridge projects or only one at Boyd Drive and Radio Blvd? Is there additional work under this RFP that would include Dark Canyon at San Jose Blvd?

Please see the amended scope of work as provided by the Project Manager for the City. The bridge project only includes design work for a bridge to be located at Boyd Dr. and Radio Blvd. See below:

Dark Canyon is a 26 mile long drainage basin originating in the Guadalupe Mountains west of Carlsbad, NM. The basin collects storm water over an area of 451 square miles. Currently when Dark Canyon floods there is only one bridge that is capable of allowing safe crossing of Dark Canyon from North to South Carlsbad, this is a major safety concern for emergency services and accessibility to citizens. The purpose of this RFP is to select qualified engineering firm to provide a complete engineer design and construction administration for a bridge to be located at the intersection of Boyd and Radio. The selected alignment for the bridge that was approved by the City of Carlsbad City Council is attached.
