Refuse Container Replacement Program Update

The enclosed City Map reflects the current status of the Refuse Container Replacement Program. Most of the residential service metal dumpsters located on city streets, have been removed and replaced by 96 gallons plastic roll-outs, so all the areas on the map highlighted in yellow, have been converted to rollouts.

The red and green dots on the map show the locations of metal dumpsters which are yet to be removed from the streets and replaced with roll-outs (red dots), or were either removed or schedule to be removed but a call from the Mayor's office or the City Administrator's office directed Solid Waste Personnel to leave the metal dumpster in place (green dots).

The areas highlighted in purple show alleys which are too hazardous or none existing for the Solid Waste Department to continue to run trucks through. Metal dumpsters had already been removed from some of these alleys, and replaced with roll-outs, such alleys are highlighted in blue.

The Solid Waste Department is currently removing the remaining residential dumpsters located on the streets (red dots). The dumpsters in the alleys considered to be hazardous will also be removed the week of March 24, 2014.

The areas of town not highlighted at all are serviced from existing alleys. As a final phase of the replacement program, the Solid Waste Department's proposes to start removing the dumpsters from these areas and replacing them with plastic roll-outs to be serviced off the streets. The department plans to start at the south end of the city and work north. The first area targeted will be the Hagerman Acres area.
