4. Utilities Department Monthly Reports presented by Ivan Abell

I. Abell reported they pumped about 486 acre-feet from the Sheep Draw wellfield, which is about 5.2 million gallons a day. In the Double Eagle Water System, they pumped about 70 acre-feet and delivered about 15 acre-feet to the City. The WWTP treated about 78.5 million gallons of

sewage and treated about 118,125 gallons of septage. They delivered about 8.1 million gallons of Effluent to the Municipal Golf Course and had about 1.3 million of Effluent Sales.

There was about .05 inches of precipitation for the month of December and .034 inches for the month of November.

5. October Financial Reports presented by Melissa Salcido

M. Salcido gave a summary of the October 2023 Financials. The Water & Sewer Fund had a beginning fund balance of \$16.2 million. Revenues budget has a balance of \$6.9 million were \$740K unfavorable to the \$7.6 million budget. This is due to waiting on grant reimbursements. Labor costs of \$1.7 million were \$44 thousand favorable to the \$1.7 million budget. Operating costs of \$980 thousand were \$401 thousand favorable to the \$1.3 million budget. Capital Investment of \$1.7 million was \$7.7 million favorable to the \$9.4 million budget.
