The issue of double penetration versus single penetration was discussed and everyone agreed that double penetration was the way to go.

One team, Turquoise Nation dropped out of the tournament due to the high price of motel rooms in the area according to our District Administrator.

9. Report on Swing for the Rings USSSA Softball Tournament

Ted Cordova explained that the tournament, run by Jeff Munro, ran smoothly and everything went well with the exception of an altercation between two teams. There were 52 teams participating and about 40 RVs on the parking lot. 193 games were played during weekend play making it a very busy tournament. We had many compliments on the condition of the complex and how everything was organized.
