# 1. ROLL CALL OF VOTING MEMBERS AND DETERMINATION OF QUORUM:

**Chairman Don Neighbors** called the meeting to order and it was determined that there was a Quorum of the Voting Members.

### 2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA:

**Ms. Pinching** motioned to approve the agenda. **Ms. Tackett** seconded the motion. The vote was as follows: Yes – Blake, Kirby, Neighbors, Pinching, Remler, Tackett, Wiedenmann; No – None.

# 3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM REGULAR MEETING:

**Mr. Kirby** motioned to approve the minutes from the August 2, 2019 meeting. **Ms. Pinching** seconded the motion. The vote was as follows: Yes – Blake, Kirby, Neighbors, Pinching, Remler, Tackett, Wiedenmann; No – None.

### 4. UPDATE ON TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS FOR CALLOWAY DR./EIGHTH ST.:

**Mr. Neighbors** stated he spoke with **Mr. Cass** who said two things are looked at when it comes to putting traffic signs up; the cost, and will it fit in with the traffic code. **Ms. Blake** stated that if a temporary sign was put up and rotated between Calloway Dr. and Eighth St. that might be effective. **Mr. Neighbors** stated he would look more into the temporary traffic signs.

### 5. UPDATE ON EIGHTH ST. PROJECT:

**Mr. Neighbors** informed the board that he spoke to **Mr. Cass**, and **Mr. Cass** stated that the project is about 99% complete.

# 6. <u>DISCUSSION OF HANDICAP PARKING BEING USED DURING SPECIAL</u> EVENTS:

**Ms. Mann** brought this issue to the board because she went to an event at the skate park and the food vendor parked across all four handicap parking spaces. **Mr. Neighbors** asked **Ms. Carrasco** if this would be something her department could help with. She stated yes, it would be a matter of informing the vendors and event organizers to not use the handicap parking spots when they sign up for special events.

## 7. DISCUSSION ON SIDEWALKS ON N.CANAL/ SAN JOSE BLVD.:

**Mr. Neighbors** asked the board if they see any issue with the sidewalks if they would write the issue down for him, to minimize discussion on this topic at every meeting. **Mr. Neighbors** will then notify **Mr. Galindo**.

# 8. <u>DISCUSSION ON FORMULA USED TO CALCULATE NUMBER OF HANDICAP PARKING SPACES:</u>

**Mr. Galindo** informed the board that he has an ADA manual, in the manual it has a chart that shows how many handicap parking spaces are needed in a certain area and how big they should be. (ex. 1-25 parking spaces, required at least 1 handicap parking) Each member received a copy of this chart.

**Mr. Kirby** mentioned some concerns about the hospital parking spaces. **Mr. Neighbors** stated he is trying to get the CEO of the hospital to come and address this issue at a meeting in the future.

### 9. DISCUSSION OF BOARD PHONE LIST AND USE OF E-MAIL:

**Mr. Neighbors** asked the members to make sure that the information is up to date on the contact list. He also asked if it would be ok if he used e-mail to send out information, everyone agreed that was ok.

### 10. PUBLIC COMMENT:

**Ms. Carrasco** informed the board that the last public input meeting for the Comprehensive Plan is on Oct. 1, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in the New City Council Chamber at the Municipal Building.

**Ms. Pinching** brought up the heavy traffic on San Jose Blvd. **Ms. Carrasco** stated the days of getting around in 15-20 minutes are over because the traffic is bad everywhere. **Mr. Neighbors** suggested San Jose Blvd. be added to the list of streets that may need one of the temporary traffic signs posted to help with that issue.

**Ms.** Blake asked if the State was ever contacted in regards to the light pole and the traffic button at the corner of Pierce St. and Mesa St. **Mr.** Galindo stated he will try to contact the State.
