3. Approval of Minutes from the Meeting held July 14, 2023

Mr. Pfeifer made a motion to approve the Minutes; Mr. Kirby seconded the motion. The vote was as follows: Yes-- Ms. Pinching, Mr. Kirby, Mr. Pfeifer, Ms. McKibben, and Ms. Boatwright. No—None. Absent—Ms. Tackett, Ms. Allery. Abstained—None. The motion carried.

4. Discussion of sidewalk repairs

Mr. Kirby mentions a buckled sidewalk and Mr. Patterson asks if it is the sidewalk on Mermod just before the Carlsbad Irrigation District canal. Mr. Kirby agrees. Mr. Pfeifer asked who was responsible for the sidewalks. Mr. Patterson explained the city usually takes care of the sidewalks but in a residential

area, the city will step in if the issue is at an intersection. If, for instance, a tree is buckling the sidewalk, the city will ask the property owner to repair the sidewalk. **Ms. Ortiz** also brought up a sidewalk issue located at the corner of Lea and Mesa St. She said the sidewalk is not the issue but the tree obstructing the sidewalk is the issue and she plans to report it. No public comments were made.

Mr. Kirby mentions he noticed the rail on the San Jose Blvd Bridge has been repaired and is now much safer. Ms. Pinching opens for public comment. Ms. Remler inquired about the parking lot at the Dr. Office located on S. Canal. Mr. Patterson will need to get in touch with Public Works again on this issue. Ms. Halford mentions the sidewalk located on Canal St. just as you turn onto Pierce St. There are three separate buckling issues.

Ms. Pinching asks what other public buildings there are to tour. Mr. Patterson said he could not think of any other facilities but could get another presentation set up for the next meeting. He asked the members if there was anyone they would like to hear from at the next meeting. Mr. Patterson said he will try to get the Public Works Director to come and explain what can and has been done.
