0:00:00 Start Recording [10:31:26 AM]

0:00:02 1. Roll call of voting members and determination of quorum

Roll was called, confirming the presence of a quorum of board members. The following members were present—Ms. Allery, Mr. Kirby, Ms. Pinching, and Ms. Tackett. Absent—Ms. Boatwright, Mr. Pfeifer, and Ms. McKibben.

0:00:46 2. Approval of Agenda

Ms. Pinching made a motion to approve the Agenda; Mr. Tackett seconded the motion. The vote was as follows: Yes—Ms. Allery, Mr. Kirby, Ms. Pinching, and Ms. Tackett. No—None. Absent—Ms. Boatwright, Mr. Pfeifer, and Ms. McKibben. Abstained—None. The motion carried.

0:01:11 3. Approval of Minutes from the Meeting held September 8, 2023

Ms. Tackett made a motion to approve the Minutes; Ms. Pinching seconded the motion. The vote was as follows: Yes—Ms. Allery, Mr. Kirby, Ms. Pinching, and Ms. Tackett. No—None. Absent—Ms. Boatwright, Mr. Pfeifer, and Ms. McKibben. Abstained—None. The motion carried.

0:02:50 4. Discussion of sidewalk repairs

Ms. Allery asked if the board needs to send a follow-up letter to Tractor Supply regarding the Handicap Sign. Mr. Patterson said he would like to give the property owner more time to respond. Ms. Allery mentioned the flyer the board prepared stating the meetings are scheduled for the first Friday of each

month, needs to be corrected due to inaccuracy. Mr. Patterson stated he has already made those changes and has resubmitted the corrections for approval. Ms. Allery stated the Disability Advisory Board has submitted many sidewalk issues to Public Works over the last year and a half. She asked Mr. Patterson if there had been any discussion or updates. Mr. Patterson stated he has not received an update. Ms. Allery mentioned they would still like to speak to someone from the Public Works Department at the next meeting. Mr. Patterson said he would request an appearance again from the Director of Public Works or the Supervisor of the Street Department. Ms. Allery asked if there were any new sidewalk issues they needed to add to the list. Ann Halford mentioned two bad spots on the North Canal's East side between Plum and Orchard. Ms. Allery mentioned this may cause an injury to any disabled person. Tarrant Blake said she would like to resubmit a request with pictures for the sidewalk on the East side of South Halagueno, between Fox St. and Greene St. Ms. Ortiz mentioned this has been submitted to the "311" system. She said she will follow up. Ms. Allery mentioned they should place cones around the area until they can get it fixed. Ms. Blake also stated that the vehicles are still parking on the sidewalk at the welding business on the southeast corner of West Greene St. and South Halagueno. She said this is causing all foot and scooter traffic to go into the street to get through, thus causing a larger hazard for the persons and vehicle traffic. Ms. Allery mentioned that if a problem is presented maybe that discussion should also include a possible solution. She said she believed if the parking was parallel with South Halagueno, then that may keep the vehicles off the sidewalk. Ms. Blake stated, that in the meantime, this issue could be cause for a lawsuit that will be towards the City because the City is allowing this issue to continue because law enforcement is not ticketing the violators. Mr. Kirby mentioned a street bumper may help with the issue. Mr. Patterson stated he has spoken to the business owner about the issue but he has yet to see any changes. Ms. Allery inquired about how the board could go about getting the parking changed to parallel parking and possibly posting some temporary signage stating the changes. Mr. Patterson stated they could make a proposal to the City Administration office for approval. Ms. Allery asked if the fence was permitted. Mr. Patterson said he would look into it. Ms. Allery made a recommendation to the City Administration to change the on-street parking at the property located at 302 S. Halagueno. Mr. Patterson said he would draw up some revised parking maps for the Disability Board to vote on. He Said once a choice is made, he will then submit the revision to City Administration for approval.

0:27:50 5. Review of repairs noted by board and status

Ms. Allery stated she had reviewed the issues that had been mentioned at previous meetings. She asked if anyone had noticed any improvements that had been made. Mr. Patterson mentioned that Facility Maintenance is going to switch the automatic door opener on the front doors as well as add an automatic door opener to the door entering the main office of the Planning, Engineering, and Regulations Department. He also mentioned the sidewalk on the backside of our building would be changed as well, which will include a ramp so that it is ADA compliant. Ms. Allery asked if anyone was aware if the library made the necessary changes to their accessible doors. Mr. Kirby stated they do not always work, which could be because they may forget to turn on the switch. Mr. Patterson also mentioned the Recreation Center has been slowly improving the issues mentioned during the tour. He also stated the parking lot at the Alejandro Ruiz Senior Center has been updated.

Ms. Allery asked if anyone had any businesses they would like to recognize for being ADA-compliant. Ms. Pinching presented some certificate ideas for the board to vote on. Mr. Patterson also presented some certificates he found that might have been used in the past. Ms. Blake would like to present the owner of Ooy's Express with a Recognition Certificate for being very attentive to their disabled customers. Ms. Allery asked if anyone else had any recommendations. Ms. Pinching said she would like to present one to McAlister's Deli for the same reasons.

Mr. Kirby made a motion to approve presenting a certificate to Ooy's Express; Ms. Allery seconded the motion. The vote was as follows: Yes-Ms. Allery, Mr. Kirby, Ms. Pinching, Ms. Tackett, and Ms. Boatwright. No-None. Absent-Mr. Pfeifer, and Ms. McKibben. Abstained-None. The motion carried.

Ms. Allery mentioned still wanting to speak to someone from Public Works. She also asked the board members if they had anyone in mind they would like to speak to.
