- The museum continues to receive items for the Hall of Fame exhibit. On June 1<sup>st</sup>, Sonny Throckmorton items were brought in. Emmitt Smith and Fred K. Mahaffey items are also coming in. The next Hall of Fame inductions will be for PR Leyva on July 6<sup>th</sup> and General Fred K. Mahaffey will be the next day.
- There were two recent Hall of Fame inductions Emmitt Smith on June 9th and John Wooten on the 16th.

- Edward VanScotter went on a two-week vacation from the end of May until the middle of June
- A concert in the Halagueno Arts Park was held on June 2<sup>nd</sup>, featuring singer, song-writer Betty Soo. It was a good concert, but turnout wasn't great. The idea was brought up that it might have been too hot for people to attend an outside event.
- John Lowe has been promoted to assistant city administrator; Ken Britt will now be the director of community development.
- Jed Howard's archives had to be moved out of his property as it was sold. Some of it is now at the museum. A more permanent solution has to be found for storing Jed's archives, as well as the city's archives to keep them safe and publicly available.
- The problem of how and where to store the crates for the *Flamenco!* exhibit is not solved yet. *Ojala!* comes down on June 23<sup>rd</sup>, and the Bison exhibit arrives on the 24<sup>th</sup>.
