- · January and February gift shop sales approx. \$1,000.
- The gift shop is hosting a 40% Off Sale on all books for National Book Month.
- The Fall 2023 exhibit, 'America at the Crossroads: The GUITAR and a Changing Nation' will be partially paid for in the current fiscal year. An \$18,000 deposit will be made before July 1st, 2023.
- The Museum purchased two Gary Niblett paintings from his retrospective exhibit. \$5,000 from the Amigos fund to purchase "Flyover Country" and "Apache Night Raiders" was purchased with a \$15,000 donation by the City of Carlsbad. Bank of America donated a third painting, "The Trail to Santa Fe".
- The installation of a lighting grid in the Atrium gallery was discussed for the upcoming fiscal year. This would be a Capital Project and has been requested.

- Assistant Director Edward VanScotter presented the Director's Report in Dave Morgan's absence. It was announced that Dave Morgan would be retiring on March 31st, 2023.
- The Bob and Barbara Forrest case in the Hall of Fame was revamped to include Gary Forrest.
- Mayor Dale Janway tasked the Museum with creating a Hall of Fame case featuring rodeo star Gary Tucker.
- The production of an exhibit catalog for 'Gary Niblett: His Life & Art' was discussed. Jameson Lucas is producing the catalog, and Starline Printing in Albuquerque is printing the catalog.
- · Summer Art Academy is being spearheaded by Cassie Parks. The academy will be held from June 6th to August 5th and will be themed this year around the Caverns Centennial exhibit. We are planning to host more adult classes this year.
- A \$2,000 grant was awarded by the Carlsbad Community Foundation to fund 25 field trips for Carlsbad fourth graders to see the Caverns Centennial exhibit.
- The Bataan exhibit will be expanded at the end of March to include the collection of Bataan Death March survivor Roy Castleberry, donated by his son Glen Castleberry.
