5 UPDATE & DISCUSS MAINTENANCE, CONSTRUCTION AND REPAIRS

Dina updated the board of the following:

- Lapidary Remodel Work continues on the Lapidary. City employees continue working on it with completion in the very near future.
- Audio System upgrades Speakers have been installed in the Auditorium with an additional 4 ordered for North and South walls. This will ensure a complete surround sound.
- Roadrunner Room Cook Construction has been contacted to install the window and sound panels to the Road Runner room before the end of May.
- Stripping and resealing of floors will be done at the center as soon as city workers can fit it into their schedule.
- Fitness Room Equipment TV's in the Fitness Room are not working right now due to
 equipment/billing coding issues. Techs cannot work on the televisions without
 proper coding. The problem should be resolved by Friday, May 10.
- A new Elliptical machine will be delivered Thursday May 9. A replacement treadmill will be purchased in July.
- Air Conditioning Units Repairs have been made to the Auditorium unit as well as
 the units cooling the pool room, fitness room, and Mesa room. The city HVAC
 technician has stated that the units will soon need to be replaced.

Dina informed the board of the following:

 will be for family members, grandchildren, and friends. We will have face painting,
 games etc.
