4. DISCUSS CURRENT FY 2019-2020 BUDGET

Dina informed the board that she continues to spend the budgeted funds according to plan during the first quarter of the fiscal year as much as possible. Things are falling into place for the capitol purchase of the storage room. Budget priorities include the new folding style tables in the Yucca room, the storage building, and replace carpeting in the Yucca room office and storage with new tile. Dina told the board that the order of tables for the Lapidary room was declined due to very apparent damage during shipping. This will now push the opening date for the Rock Club back to October.

Dina explained to the board that due to the transition of the new accounting system at City Hall purchases for the planned Open House / Ice cream Social and Festival were unable to get ordered to receive in time and be ready for the event. This will be rescheduled at a later date. A plan for the scheduled craft fair on October 26 is going ahead at full speed.

Dina was glad to inform the board that she has received \$10,000.00 out of capital funding for air conditioning maintenance and will begin looking into bids as well as \$6,000 for the purchase of additional shelving in the library.

5. UPDATE & DISCUSS MAINTENANCE, CONSTRUCTION AND REPAIRS

Dina updated the board of the following:

- Lapidary Remodel Work continues on the Lapidary in the form of electrical and
 plumbing. As noted above due to the tables being damaged upon delivery this has
 pushed the opening date back to possibly October. With the new window being added to
 the wall shared by the fitness room we are hoping for more interest as people will be
 able to watch the rock club members at work. A steel fire rated door will also be
 installed.
- Roadrunner Room The window and sound panels are installed and painting the
 window trim is completed in the room and is now on the activity schedule for use. Some
 additions will include installing cable TV and adding window treatments for privacy if and
 when needed.
- Stripping and resealing of floors The city crew will begin moving equipment out of the
 fitness center on Friday, August 16 to begin stripping and waxing this floor and the Mesa
 room over the weekend. Other rooms will be completed as our schedule allows.
- A/C Units After repairs were made last week the AC is cooling again however this unit
 will likely need to be replaced. As stated above money has been allocated for the
 replacements and Dina will begin getting estimates.

6. UPDATE ON NMSR ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS

Dina informed the board of the following:

- Dina reminded the members that the upcoming Ice Cream social/ Open house is now in TBD status.
- The Garage sale will be Saturday, August 17 with 26 out of 31 tables sold.
- The Craft Fair will be held October 26th. Dina informs board members that she is hoping
 to use the Lodgers Tax to fund the event. The set up will include some vendors setting
 up outdoor with use of our canopies. Vendors will be reminded that they will need to
 have a license from the city.
