Tracy Hughes presented that she would like to see the bike trail by Radio Boulevard connect to La Cueva Trail Systems. She would also like for bike lanes be installed on the Standpipe and Radio Boulevard area, but Pat Cass said it was highly used by truckers he don't think it would be a good idea for bike lanes to be installed. In the future Tracy Hughes would also like to connect La Cueva to the Carlsbad Caverns. She stated that BLM would not be able to help financially but would like for the local businesses and the City of Carlsbad would help with the budget.

1. Paint has been purchased for the Parks Department to start painting the Rocket Slide.
2. The Welding Department is in the process of fabricating the fence to enclose the Rocket Slide.
3. Speir Construction is in the process of re-roofing the restrooms and Pavilion #1 at Riverview Park and will continue at the Pavilion at Heritage Park.
4. The Street Department is in the process of extending the Police Department Shooting Range area at the Carlsbad Municipal Shooting Range.
5. The Water Department will be installing new water taps and meters for potable water to the Lake Carlsbad Recreation area restrooms, and drinking fountains.
6. Funding has been approved for A.K. Sales from Roswell, New Mexico to install Vitriturf rubber fall zone at the Rotary Club playground equipment.

Christy Thomas mentioned she would like to request a walkway for Arcadia Park and Pat Cass agreed but he would like to request one restroom every year and for more lighting for each park.

The motion was made by Christy Thomas to adjourn the meeting. Denton McCullough seconds the motion.

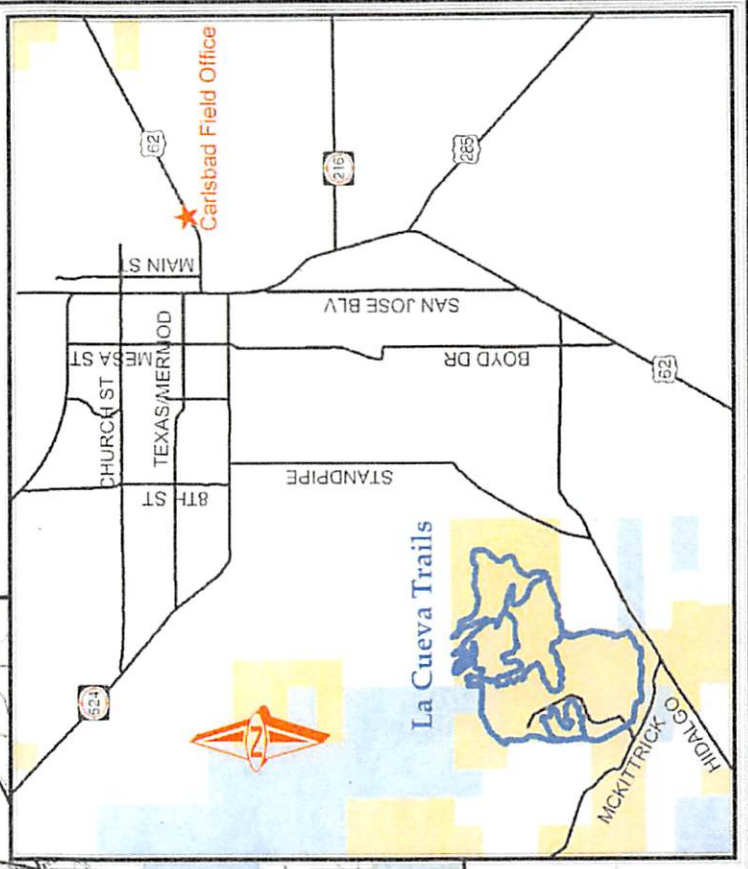
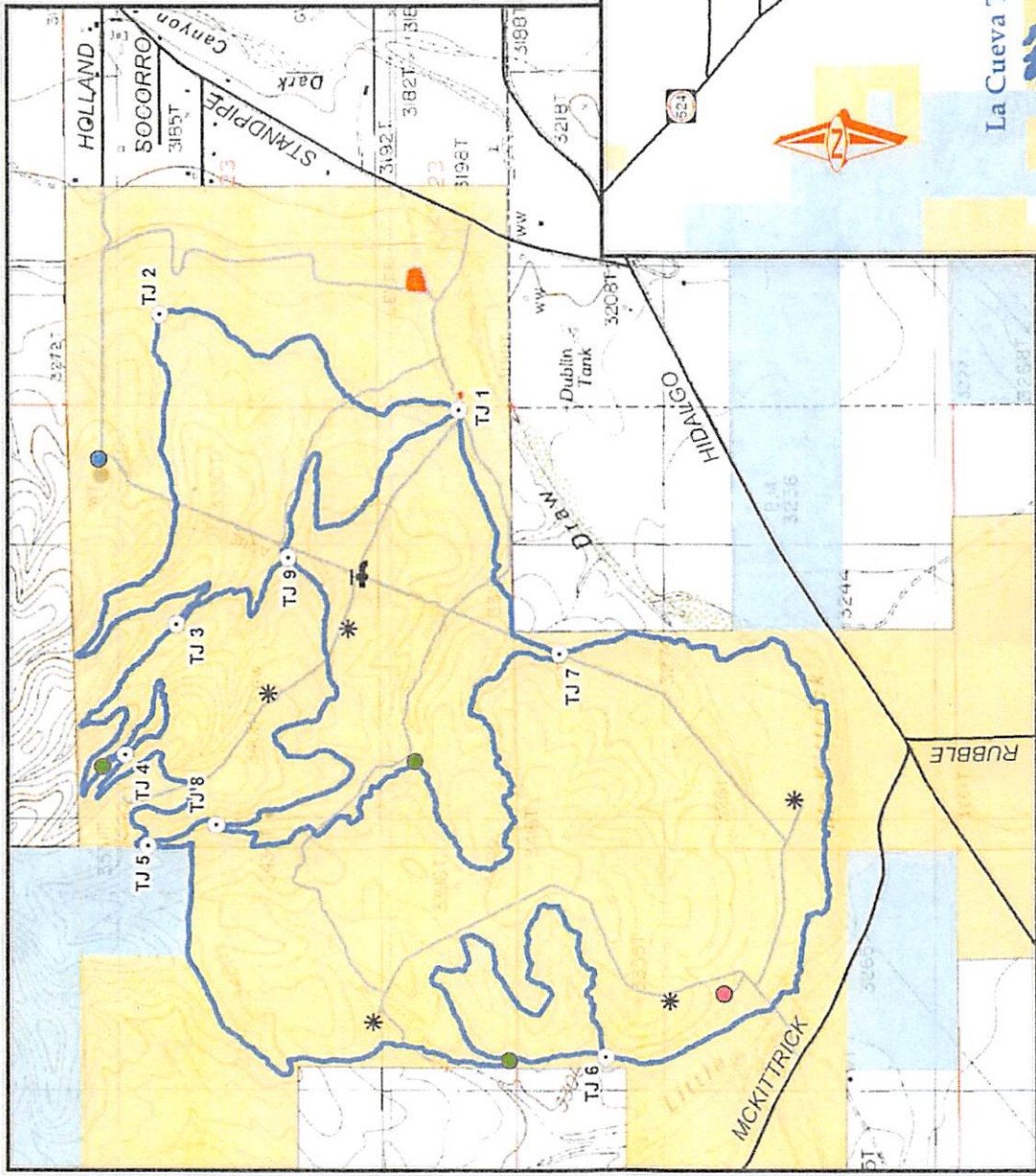
