5. MONTHLY REPORT FOR MAY 2018:

Ms. Vasquez reported the number of patrons served in May was 2,274 and the nutritional program served 1,888, for a total of 4,162 patrons served.

Ms. Vasquez stated that in May we received \$5,702.00 in bingo money. The sum of \$267.00 was held out in order to purchase more bingo cards. The amount paid out to the bingo players was \$5,435.00.

We had 6 new members sign up during this month.

6. MANAGER'S REPORT:

Ms. Vasquez stated that the following transpired during the month of May:

The San Jose Advisory Board meeting was held on the 2nd. The shopping trip to Melrose and Ross was on the 3rd. The CCVN Advisory Board meeting was held on the 7th. We had the Mother's Day Tea on May 10th and it was a big success. The ladies attending enjoyed it very much. The Mother's Day Dance was held on the 11th and we had about 80 people in attendance. Everyone had a good time. The AARP representative held a Safe Driving Class on the 17th which was well attended. The Medicare Representative gave a presentation to the seniors on the 30th. The May birthdays were celebrated on the 31st.

Upcoming events for June: A meeting was held with the Leadership Eddy County Group on June 1st. It was decided that they along with the CCVN Coordinator will have a booth

at the CavernFest on the 9th to advertise and inform the community about the CCVN and recruit new volunteers. CCVN will have their Advisory Board Meeting on the 4th. San Jose Advisory Board will be held on the 6th. The Cardiovascular Associates of Carlsbad will have a Free Heart Healthy Information Session on Saturday, June 9th.
