### **6. MANAGER'S REPORT:**

Ms. Vasquez stated the following:

The Center was open for indoor dining on July 6, 2021. The count is low, however we expect the numbers to increase. The center is averaging 50 to 55 patrons per day, which is low compared to the Grab and Go numbers of 140 to 160 patrons.

We have lost about 35 of our members that have passed on. We have a good number of people playing pool, line dancing, crafts and quilting. We get many calls as to when we will start having Bingo and the Friday Dances. On July 29<sup>th</sup> we had a welcome back seniors party. The band The Jammers played for the crowd. We served ice cream and cupcakes. The Jammers are scheduled to come back every other week to play for us.

Regarding the renovations to Pate School, Angelica Barrios-Testa, the Director of Municipal Services and Capital Programs, informed me that renovations are progressing and a grant applied for has been approved which will help tremendously with the work that needs to be done at the school.

Upcoming events for August:


