Please help us keep our park beautiful and safe:

- Enjoy sculpture, plantings and architectural features from a distance. No climbing.
- No roller skates, inline skates or skateboards in park. Winding pathways are for foot traffic only.
- Please park bikes in provided racks.
- Thank you for leashing your pet at all times and removing waste.
- Trash receptacles are available for your convenience.
- Group visits are welcome, but sponsored events or commercial activities must be approved and scheduled through the Municipal Events Coordinator.
- Vending and commercial activities are permitted on the street as part of an approved public event only. All vehicles must remain on the street to avoid damage to sidewalks and irrigation.
- Activities which interfere with the enjoyment of the park by other visitors are not permitted. No alcohol, advertising, or panhandling is allowed.
- The Park is a tobacco free zone. This includes cigarettes, cigars, pipe tobacco, chewing tobacco, snuff, snus, electronic smoking devices, or other similar products.
- The park closes at 8:00 p.m. except during special events authorized through the Municipal Events Coordinator.
- Violators may receive a verbal warning, a legal citation, or be asked to leave the park.
 Violations may result in the issuance of a Criminal Trespass Warning and being barred from the park.
