Knowledge of the City of Carlsbad's animal control ordinances. Knowledge of methods, techniques, and practices for capturing animals, including the types of equipment appropriate for use. Knowledge of the names and locations of streets in the City of Carlsbad.

Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with other department/City staff and the public. Ability to follow oral and written instructions, procedures, and guidelines. Ability to communicate using standard telephone and two-way radio equipment. Skill in capturing stray and/or injured animals.

Requires the ability to communicate effectively, both verbally and in writing, and to work closely with the public.
