

CARETAKER

The City of Carlsbad is accepting applications for a Caretaker position in the Golf Department. Responsible for performing strenuous unskilled or semi-skilled labor of routine difficulty.

Mows lawns, trims plants and shrubs, and prunes bushes and trees. Physically moves large quantities of dirt and turf.

Assists equipment operators in a variety of work settings to ensure safe and efficient completion of assigned projects.

Sets up and operates portable sprinkler systems. Operates equipment such as riding lawn mowers, weed-eaters, and pickup trucks.

Knowledge of occupational hazards and safety precautions.

Ability to perform manual labor requiring extensive physical exertion and prolonged exposure to the environment. Ability to receive and follow oral and written instructions. Ability to lift objects weighing 75 lbs. or more. Ability to perform tasks requiring manual dexterity.

Skill in the use of a variety of hand and power tools.

Qualifications: High school diploma or GED. Experience equivalent to six (6) months of full-time work involving considerable physical exertion.

Must have an excellent work history to include dependability and stability. Must possess and maintain a valid New Mexico driver's license.
